SCOPE

Medical Mobile Units conduct General Health Check-up camps at various places in and around its selected villages. 3 such camps were held in the month of February 2023 at Bhadas, Botarwadi, and Shelkewadi. The camp at Shelkewadi was specifically directed at Brick Kiln workers.

At these places, the camps are conducted by initially introducing the SCOPE and SUHRC. Free hospital services at SUHRC and MJPJAY / PMJAY availability are then explained. The general health check-up and medicine distribution are done and after that patients requiring specialty consultation are counseled and referred for further examination and treatment at SUHRC.






Stress Management Workshop:
